We created 30 Prompts. 30 Spiritual Conversations. to support you in the spiritual journey of parenting. These prompts give parents insight into their child's wonder about life, God, Jesus, and themselves. Some of the prompts have Scriptural references, while others simply reveal your child's heart and imagination.

The goal is to create an opportune time to have an informal conversation about God and Jesus, to foster connection rather than offer direction or correction.



There are multiple ways to use 30 Prompts. 30 Spiritual Conversations. Pick the one that best fits your family, or create your own!
